The 11th International Conference on CANDU® Maintenance and Nuclear Components (CMNCC 2017) will be held October 1-4, 2017. The CMNCC 2017 program has been built around the needs and interests of the operating utilities with a focus on plant maintenance and life extension.

Front-line maintenance workers are integral to plant maintenance and they need access to innovative approaches to improve maintenance productivity through automation, advanced technology and applications that provide them with essential information to execute their tasks efficiently and effectively.

CMNCC will be the forum to launch the first **Utility Engagement Panel on Maintenance** that will be in a workshop format with a panel of maintenance representatives from Ontario Power Generation, Bruce Power, NB Power and Canadian Nuclear Laboratories. The panelists will identify key maintenance issues (current or foreseen in the future) as the basis for interactive discussion with solutions-oriented service providers, equipment vendors and exhibitors, to explore efforts that may be underway to address the issues. The issues will be published to registered conference and event-only participants in advance to better enable meaningful discussion.
